REGULATIONS

## CHAPTER I

### GENERAL PROVISIONS

The regulations of the 2nd International Competition for Soloists of Wooden and Copper Wind Instruments "MUZIKOS GŪSIS 2025" (hereinafter referred to as the competition) regulate the purpose of the competition, the procedure for organizing, evaluating and awarding the participants. Students of music and art schools playing wind musical instruments are invited to participate in the competition.

## CHAPTER II

### GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

The aim of the competition is

- Promote students' artistic-musical self-expression, stimulate their creativity, develop taste;
- Reveal the musical abilities of children, develop skills of artistic-musical expression;
- Popularize the music of wind instruments, revealing their individuality;
- Foster musical traditions, give children the opportunity to gain stage experience;
- Encourage creative collaboration between educators and performers.

## CHAPTER III

### TERMS OF THE COMPETITION

- The contestants perform two freely chosen pieces (preferably of a different character or epoch).
- Competition is one round without compulsory pieces.
- The program is performed by heart.
- Contestant's may not exceed the duration of the programme specified for that category (the jury has the right to suspend the performance if the time is exceeded).
- Sound amplification cannot be used in the competition.
- The competition is public.

Participants are divided into groups:

GROUP	CLASS	PERFORMANCE DURATION
Group A	Students in grades 1-2	Up to 4 min.
Group B	Students in grades 3-4	Up to 6 min.
Group C	Students in grades 5-6	Up to 8 min.
Group D	Students in grades 7-8	Up to 10 min.
Group E	Students in grades 9-10	Up to 12 min.
Group F	Students in grades 11-12	Up to 15 min.

## CHAPTER IV

### ASSESSMENT AND AWARDS

Criteria for evaluating the competition:

- sound quality and intonation of the performed work;
- accuracy of technical performance;
- artistry of the performer.

The best-performing participants will be awarded the laureate's diplomas and memorial gifts. All teachers and concertmasters will be presented with participating diplomas.



The laureates will be awarded on the basis of the average number of points of the members of the commission:

- First place winner's diploma - 23 - 25 points
- Second place winner's diploma - 20 - 22.99 points
- Third place winner's diploma - 18 - 19.99 points
- Participant's diploma - 16 - 17.99 points

- The jury reserves the right to appoint grand prix diploma winners in each age group.
- The names of the jury members will be announced before the start of the event.
- The decisions of the jury are final and not subject to appeal.

#### CHAPTER V

#### ORGANISATION OF THE COMPETITION

The first international competition for soloists of wooden and copper wind instruments MUZIKOS GŪSIS 2025 is organized by Kupiškis Art School.

**The competition will take place on April 25, 2024, 9 a.m. at Kupiškis Art School, address Gedimino str. 46, Kupiškis. Registration of participants - from 8 am.**
